



The Carnegie Arts Center is celebrating California!

Young artists, ages 4-18, are invited to submit artwork that may be featured on banners to be displayed along Main Street and Broadway in Downtown Turlock this Fall.

See below for rules and procedures for participating in this fun and unique opportunity.

WHO: Artists must be between 4-18 years of age. Our committee will select at least 10 winners whose artwork will be printed on 2 or more street banners that will be displayed in Downtown Turlock. Artwork will be judged for creativity, response to the theme, and technique or skill (relative to age).

WHAT: To get everyone excited about the coming year full of fun and creativity, we are seeking artwork that highlights something you love about California. It can be realistic or abstract, and made in any drawing or painting medium.

Create your artwork in a vertical format on paper that is 14 x 8 ½” (legal size). This will make it easy to use as a street banner. (If you don't have the right size paper, stop by the CAC and we will give you some.) Be sure it is colorful so that it will stand out!

WHEN: Bring your design to us! Deliver your original artwork with a completed entry form to the CAC at 250 N. Broadway in Turlock. Entries will be received **AUGUST 2 – SEPTEMBER 3**. **Open hours: Tuesday-Saturday from 10 a.m. – 5 p.m.**

EXHIBITION: Winning entries will be scanned, formatted, and displayed as street banners during the Fall of 2022 (specific dates to be announced). All of the entries for the banner contest will be kept and included in the annual **Ready, Set, Show! Youth Art Exhibition** in June 2023.

RULES CAC reserves the right to exclude any entries that do not follow these guidelines:

- 1 Artists must be between the ages of 4-18 during the contest period. Content must be family-friendly and age appropriate.
- 2 Entries must be the original creative work of the artist and must follow the specific format guidelines. No copies, facsimiles, or pre-printed pages will be accepted.
- 3 By submitting an entry, the parent/guardian of the artist acknowledges that she/he will comply with all rules, regulations, and deadlines of the contest.
- 4 All entries will become the property of the Carnegie Arts Center Foundation, and may be used, reprinted, reformatted and exhibited at the discretion of the CACF.
