Fees

Non-refundable entry fee is \$2 per work for non-members. Entries are free for artists whose parent(s), grandparent(s), or guardian(s) are members of the CAC. **Each artist may enter up to 3 works.**

All entries for the CAC's 10th Anniversary Downtown **Street Banner Contest** (August 2021) will automatically be included in the exhibition. No fee or paperwork is needed.

- Painting & Mixed Media**

How to Participate

Visit the website at www.CarnegieArtsTurlock.org and click on the link for exhibitions to access an entry form, or pick one up at the CAC information desk. Entry forms must be completed and returned to the CAC with the artwork on delivery dates below. Payments may be made by cash/check/credit card in person at the CAC.

Delivery & Pick-up

All artwork must have a completed entry form and be **delivered to the CAC in Turlock** at the address above. Deliveries will only be received on the following dates:

- Saturday May 21, from 10 a.m. – 5 p.m.**
- Tuesday, May 24, from 10 a.m. – 5 p.m.**
- Wednesday, May 25, from 10 a.m. – 5 p.m.**
- Thursday, May 26, from 10 a.m. – 5 p.m.**
- Friday, May 27, from 10 a.m. – 5 p.m.**
- Saturday, May 28, from 10 a.m. – 5 p.m.**

Works included in the exhibition should be picked up after the show closes on June 25. Pick up any time before July 30 during regular business hours:

Tuesday - Saturday from 10 a.m. – 5 p.m.

Works not picked up by July 30 become the property of the Carnegie Arts Center Foundation and may be disposed of in any manner at the sole discretion of the organization.

Exhibition Details

The exhibition will be on view from June 3-25, 2022.

Gallery hours at the Carnegie Arts Center are:

Tuesday - Saturday from 10 a.m. – 5 p.m.

Admission is \$7 general; \$5 Seniors; free for CAC members and children/students 18 and under. Admission is free for everyone on the first Friday of every month.

Reception

A free public reception to celebrate the artists will be held as part of our **Family Friday: Let's Go to the Art Show!** event on June 3, at 7 p.m.

RULES CAC reserves the right to exclude any entries that do not follow these guidelines:

- Content must be family-friendly and age appropriate.
- Entries must be the original creative work of the artist. No copies, facsimiles, or pre-printed coloring pages will be accepted.
- Artists must be attending school or eligible to attend school in grades K-12 as of May 2022. High School Seniors who have graduated may submit entries.
- Artists or their legal guardian must reside in Stanislaus, Merced or San Joaquin County.
- By submitting an entry the parent/guardian of the artist acknowledges that she/he will comply with all rules, regulations, and deadlines of the exhibition.
- All works must be dry and ready to install.

NOTE!

Works on paper/photographs should be mounted on construction paper, poster board or mat board.

No frames, glass or Plexiglas allowed.

- No entry, once accepted for the exhibition, may be removed prior to the official closing date as set forth in the entry form.
